How Does It Work?



- The project has four ebikes available (Raleigh Evo 20s).
- The e-bikes can be borrowed **free of charge** for up to three weeks at a time.
- Bikes can be collected from two locations - the Ore Valley Business Centre in Lochgelly and the OVHA Head Office in Cardenden.
- The bikes are available to those aged 18 or older only but it is free to register and borrow the bikes - you just need to complete the registration form and provide evidence of your identity for record-keeping purposes.
- All equipment is provided including helmets, high visibility vests, front and rear lights, charging cables, phone holder, cycling computer, sunglasses, padlock etc.
- The bikes will provide up to 30 miles of range when fully charged enabling users to get to Glenrothes or Dunfermline and back on a single charge.
- The bikes can be folded up to allow them to be carried on public transport such as buses or trains, increasing the range of potential integration with additional sustainable travel options.
