# **Getting to Know You Survey**

Thank you to everyone who took part in our 'Getting to Know You' Survey. Over 500 tenants responded to this survey that was conducted on our behalf by Research Resource. The insights and equalities data that we have gathered will be used to update and improve our services so that we can deliver a more tailored service based on your specific needs.

## **Rent Increase - 2025/2026**


Following careful consideration our Board have approved an overall rent increase of 4.6% for 2025/2026. This means that the following weekly increases will be applied to our social rented properties from 1st April 2025.

Our agreed increase of 4.6% represents an increase of inflation +2% which will allow us to maintain our services while still being able to deliver our planned component replacement programme comprising new bathrooms, kitchens and external doors and windows for our older stock transfer properties in Bowhill and Cardenden.

The increase we are introducing is lower or similar to those being proposed by the other Social Landlords in Fife and throughout Scotland and reflects the budget pressures and increasing financial demands being placed on Social Housing due to higher inflationary costs and an overall increase in the cost of living.

Further information about our rent increase, including support we can provide if you are having difficulty paying your rent is available on our website, along with the results and tenant feedback from our rent consultation survey.



104 tenants responded to our 2025/2026 rent consultation survey (91 online), equating to 14.4% of the maximum potential response.

86% of the tenants (89) supported a proposed increase of 4.6% or more. 14% of the tenants (15) preferred no increase or suggested an alternative option.

#### **Garden Assistance Scheme 2025**

Ore Valley Housing Association recognises that some tenants may not be able to maintain their garden or have family to help out. Whilst the garden assistance is subsidised by the Association there is an annual cost to tenants wishing to participate in the scheme which is currently £90.00, payable upon confirmation of acceptance to the scheme.

We will contact those who were part of the scheme last year to offer this scheme for the period from April to October 2025, New applications will be considered but there is very limited capacity to be accepted to the scheme.

## **Gas Safety Letters**

Ore Valley Housing Association is committed to ensuring the safety and comfort of all our tenants. As part of this commitment, we conduct annual gas servicing to confirm the safety and working order of your boiler and heating equipment, as required by law.

To facilitate this process, we have implemented an automated reminder system that sends out a series of five letters at specific intervals:

- **60-Day Notice:** This initial reminder is sent 60 days before your scheduled service date, prompting you to make arrangements with our gas contractor, Rogerson Plumbing & Heating.
- **30-Day Notice:** A follow-up reminder is sent 30 days before the service date to ensure you have scheduled your appointment.
- 15-Day Notice: As the service date approaches, a reminder is sent 15 days in advance.
- **7-Day Notice:** A final reminder is sent 7 days before the service date to confirm your appointment.
- Final Notice: If no appointment has been scheduled, a final notice is sent, warning that your gas supply may be capped, which will incur a charge to the tenant.

Please note that we are required to issue these letters until the gas service has been completed. If you have made an appointment before receiving your letter please disregard the letter.


